

Advances in Lunar Magnetism

From Paleomagnetism to Dynamos

Location: Institut d'Etudes Scientifique de Cargèse, France

Start: 2 pm, Wednesday, June 1

End: 5 pm, Friday, June 3

Travel instructions:

Participants will need to arrive either at the Ajaccio airport (AJA) or Ajaccio harbor. From there, we will organize transfer to Cargèse either by bus or by personal cars from the french participants. Car rentals are available at the Ajaccio airport, and taxis are also available to Cargèse for about 100 €.

By plane:

Participants should plan on arriving at the Ajaccio airport before Wednesday, 11 am. Ajaccio (AJA) airport has flights to and from:

- Paris Orly (ORY). *Please note that the Orly and Charles de Gaulle airports are on opposite sides of the Paris. If transferring directly from CDG to ORY, anticipate 4 hours, which will include luggage collection and transfer by bus.*
- Paris Charles de Gaulle (CDG). Easy Jet has a daily flight to AJA.
- Nice (NCE). NCE hosts many international flights and might be a better choice than flying into Paris.
- Marseille (MRS). The Marseille airport can be reached from CDG, Amsterdam (by KLM), and Germany (by Lufthansa).

By ferry:

Due to the recent bankruptcy of the main ferry company, the possibilities to reach Ajaccio by ferry are rather limited. Ajaccio has an overnight ferry to and from Marseille with Maritima and Méridionale. Ferries leave typically at 7 pm and arrive at 7 am in Ajaccio. There are no ferries from Nice at this time of the year.

Train:

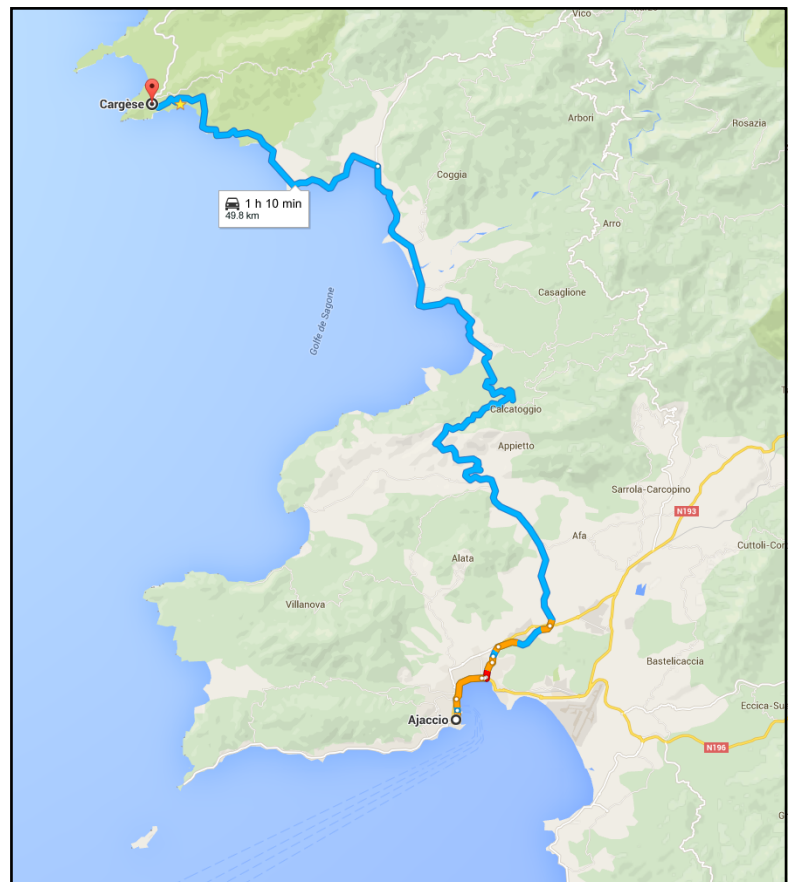
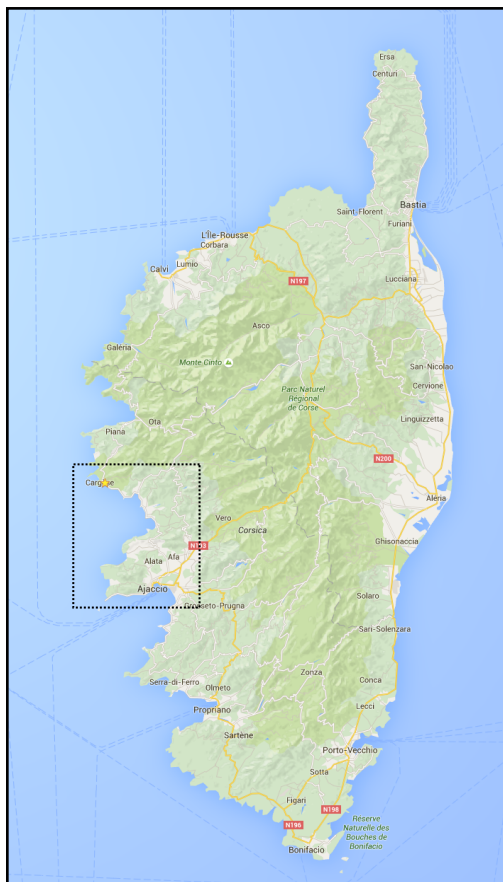
There is a high-speed rail line from central Paris (Gare de Lyon) and the Charles de Gaulle airport to Marseille and Aix-en-Provence. Trains leave every hour and take about 3 hours. Information on buying tickets can be found at the [SNCF web site](http://www.sncf.com).

Coordination with french participants:

Please note that there will be several french participants coming from Paris, Aix-en-Provence/ Marseille, and Nice. Coordinating with them might make things easier for you. If you plan on staying in either of these cities before or after the meeting, we would be happy to give you advice.

In particular, the CEREGE group will take the ferry from Marseille to Ajaccio on Tuesday night with their personal cars. They can pick up international travelers at either the MRS airport or the Aix-en-Provence TGV train station on Tuesday May 31 before 4 pm and take them to the ferry.
